6. Manage Change

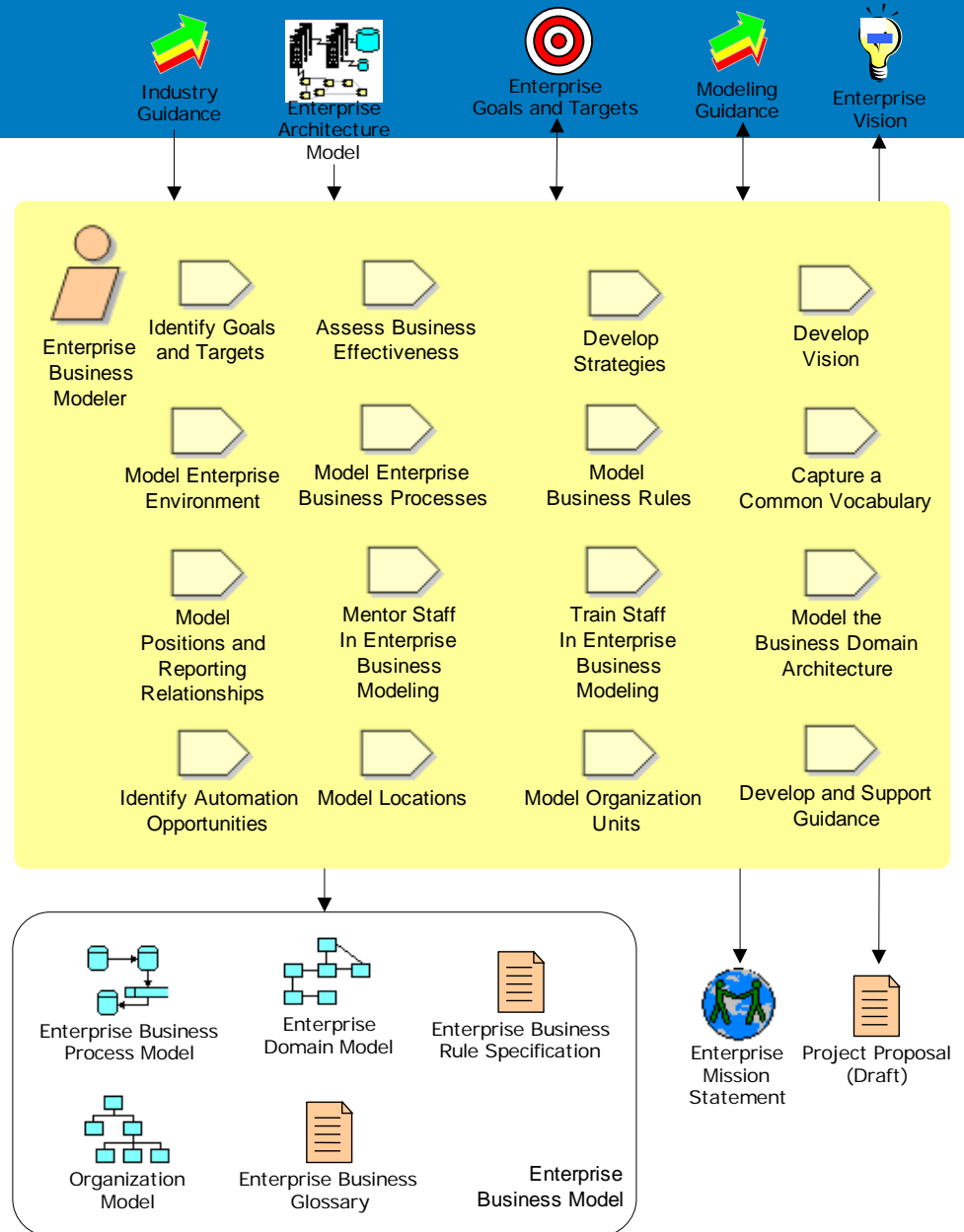

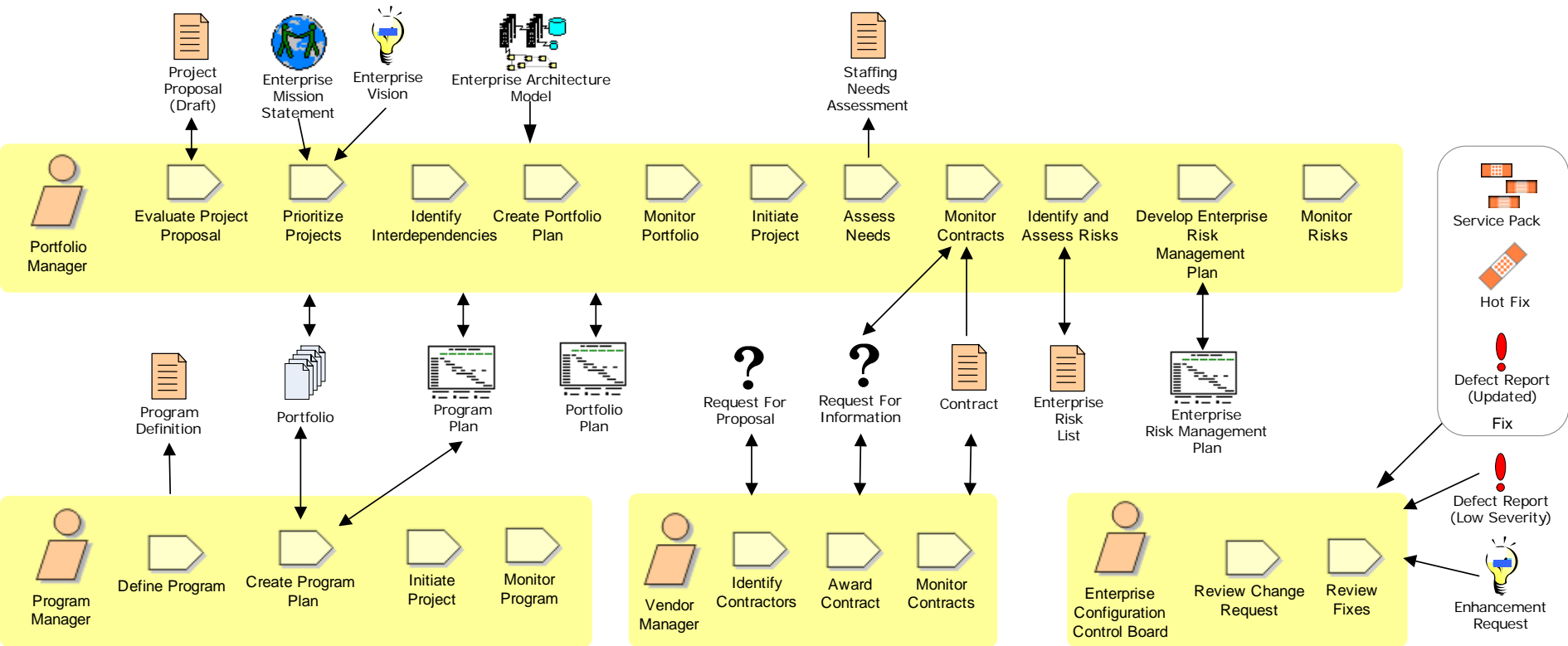
1. Develop Iteratively

10. Manage Risk

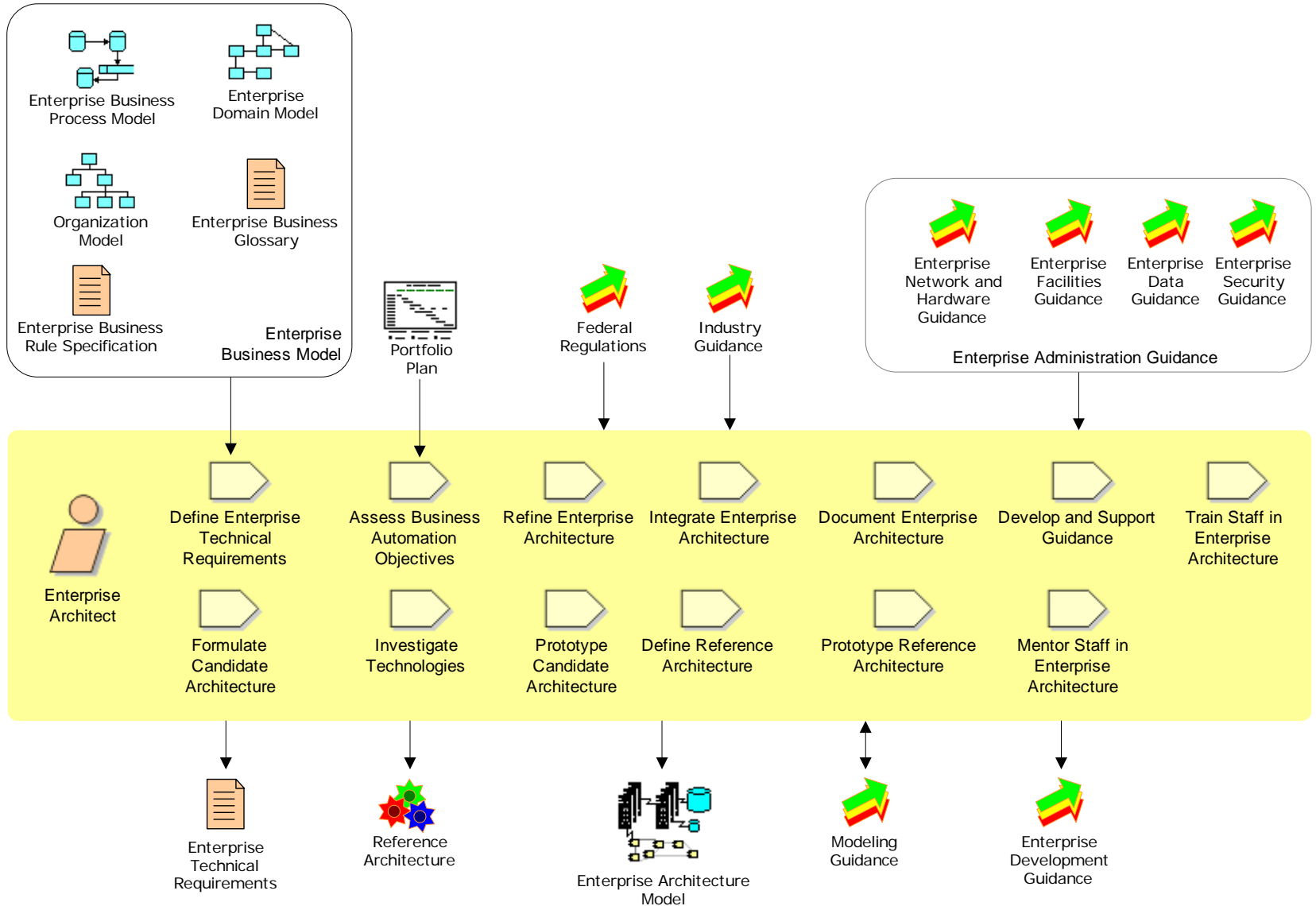


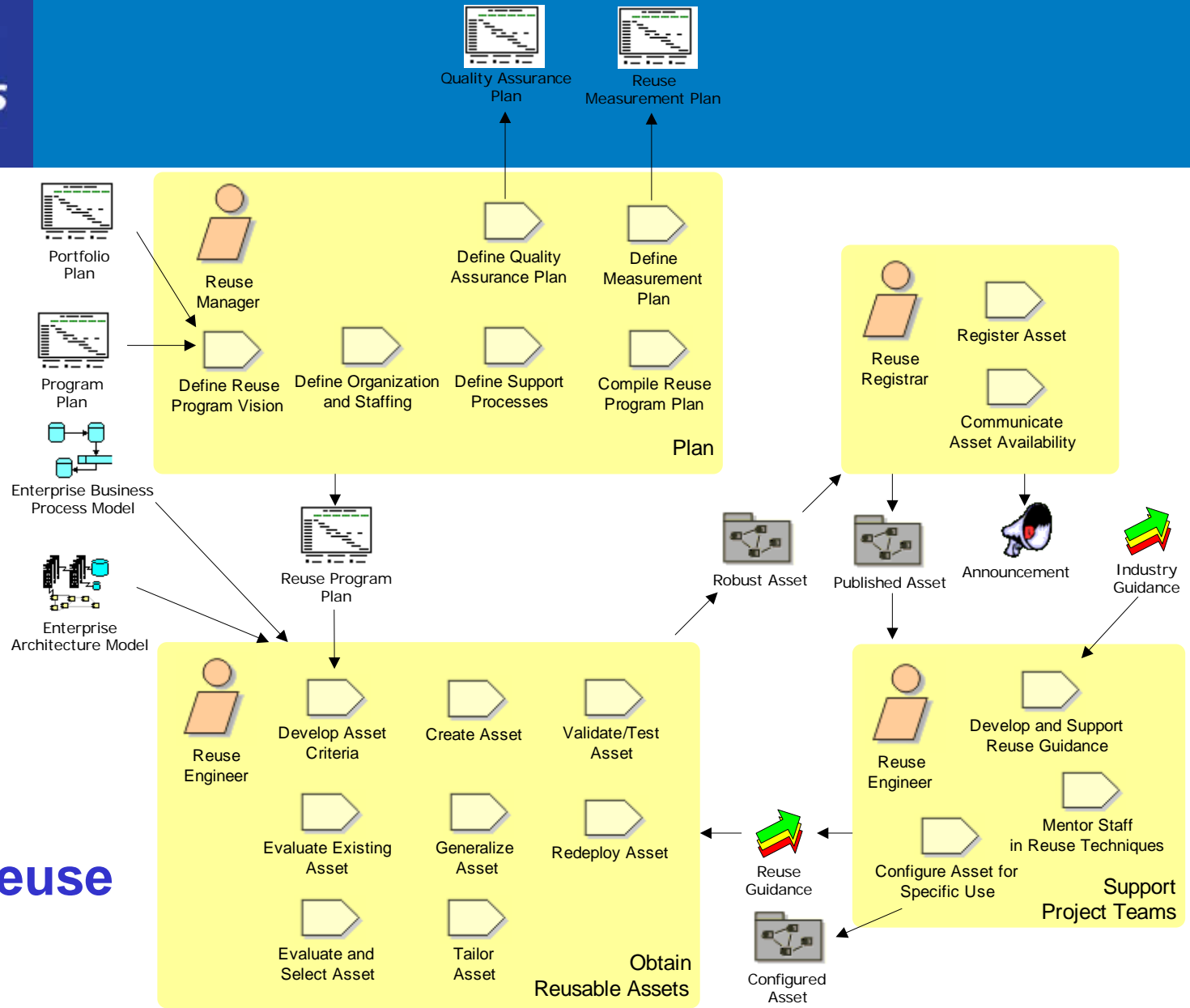
